Introduction to iNaturalist | Silver City Library, 2-4pm | Learn more about community science, the global City Nature Challenge event, and the iNaturalist app.

Friday, April 24th

Gila Valley Pollinator Gardens | Gila Valley Public Library, 12-2pm | Kid-friendly event exploring the diversity of wildlife that benefit from pollinator gardens.

Dragonfly Trail Hike | Dragonfly Trailhead, 4-6pm | View desert wildflowers, birds, insects, and mammals that gather along streams on this classic local trail.

Open Space Welcome | Open Space Brewing, 6:30pm-onward | Meet fellow community scientists to share your observations and challenges from the first day of CNC 2026.

Bootheel Bioblitz | Continental Divide Trail near Hachita, 5-7pm | Explore the county's bootheel to find rare reptile species like Gila monsters and a diversity of blooming cacti.
