



FIRE RESTRICTIONS

(Flame, Fire & Burn Restrictions)



Fire Hazards Are Prohibited

It is unlawful to:

- Maintain unsafe accumulations of flammable materials
- Leave vacant buildings unsecured with flammable debris inside
- Discard lit cigarettes, matches, or other burning materials
- Allow fires to escape control or leave fires unattended

Fire Restrictions During Drought or Emergencies

Fire restrictions for unincorporated areas of Grant County include:

- Prohibition of open fires, including campfires and charcoal grills (with limited exceptions in designated developed campgrounds)
- Prohibition of open burning of debris, trash, fields, or vegetation
- Restrictions on outdoor smoking
- Restrictions on welding unless specific safety measures are in place
- Prohibition of fireworks, aerial devices, and other ignition sources deemed hazardous
- Additional restrictions as posted for specific areas
- Restrictions remain in effect until officially lifted and will be publicly posted and published.

Penalties & Enforcement

- Violations are a misdemeanor
- Penalties may include:
 - Fines of up to \$300
 - Up to 90 days in jail
 - Or both
