## **NATIONAL AG MECH TEAM**

The Silver City FFA Ag mech team competed at the National FFA Agricultural Mechanics and technology contest the last week of October. The following students competed: Walter Woodward, Kathryn Woodward, Colter Massengill, and Trey Greeman. The team overall placed 12th out of 44 teams and earned a Gold ranking (top 1/3). Walter placed 28th out of 172 participants and earned a Gold Ranking with a score of 190.25, Kathryn placed 35th our of 172 participants and earned a Gold Ranking with a score of 185.75, Colter placed 55th out of 172 participants earning a Silver Ranking with a score of 174.75, and Trey placed 129 out of 172 participants earning a Bronze ranking with a score of 146.25.

Some components of the competition included: including structural welding, how to rebuild an engine, troubleshoot a lawnmower, reading wiring diagrams and wire electric motors, mix and pour concrete, using surveying equipment, develop an understanding of environmental resources and mechanical industry.
