LAS CRUCES, NM – May 28, 2026 – Last night, during a full circle headline performance at the New Mexico State FFA Convention, New Mexico-born troubadour **Tyce Delk** got the surprise of a lifetime, honored with an invitation to step into the **Grand Ole Opry's** iconic Circle for his official debut on **July 16, 2026**.

In a truly special moment, Tyce's father, **Neal Delk**, made the official ask alongside other members of family band, **The Delk Band**, who will join Tyce at his official debut for an incredibly special, generation-spanning performance.

"Tyce Delk has grown up surrounded by music, but more importantly, he's grown up with a love and respect for the people and traditions behind it," **Neal said in a surprise pop up during Tyce's set.** "Seeing him carry on what started nearly a century ago means more to our family than words can truly express. Tyce, we are incredibly proud of you — not just for your talent, but for your heart, your humility, and the way you represent our family and our heritage. And tonight, it's our honor to announce your upcoming appearance at the Grand Ole Opry on July 16th."

The Delk Band was founded in 1934 by Tyce's great grandfather, Forrest Delk, when he was just 17-years-old. Over the course of the band's 92 year history, they've performed across the Southwest and Texas, spanning several generations of Delks.
