
Number of Deaths by Race/Ethnicity Each Month



This image shows the relative levels of deaths from COVID-19 disease among five major racial/ethnic groups within the State of New Mexico. The yellow line represents the number of COVID-19 deaths among Hispanic Americans in New Mexico, the green line represents the number of COVID-19 deaths among Whites in New Mexico, and the blue line represents the number of COVID-19 deaths among Native Americans in New Mexico. The gray line, representing the number of COVID-19 deaths among Blacks in New Mexico, and the orange line, representing the number of COVID-19 deaths among Blacks in New Mexico, and the orange line, representing the number of COVID-19 deaths among Blacks in New Mexico, and the orange line, representing the number of COVID-19 deaths among Americans of Asian and Pacific Island heritage, overlap one another for many months in this graph.
